EDITORIAL GUIDELINES

SUBMISSION: Contributions should be sent as **digital files**, in **Word** and **Excel** and digital photos with minimum resolution 300 dpi. Text and captions (use different files) should be included,

PLEASE, without any character and paragraph style formatting!

The references in the **bibliography** must have the formatting given below.

Please, use **Times New Roman 11, one font size throughout**.

Tables must be in separate files from the text: preferred format is Microsoft Excel.

Figures must be in separate files from the text: preferred format .jpg or .tif.

REFERENCES: We follow the author year, page- system, with an alphabetically ordered bibliography at the end, giving surname and initial/initials of all authors (not *et al.*), year, title, **full title of the review, journal, book** etc., for reviews the volume and the **first** and **last** page of the article.

For example:

Lamb H. H. and Tessier L., 1987, *Weather, Climate and Human Affairs*, Routledge, London.

Cruise G. M., 1990, Pollen stratigraphy of two Holocene peat sites, *Review of Paleobotany and Palynology* 6 (1), 299–313.

Serre-Bachet F., Guiot J. and Tessier L., 1992, La dendroclimatologie; pour une histoire du climat, in *Les veines du temps*, Catalogue d'exposition, Musée du Monde, Paris, 93–119.

Long D. 1993, An ash fall within the Loch Lomond Stadial, *Journal of Quaternary Science* 2, 97–103.

Foster I. D. L. and Grew R., 1990, Magnitude and frequency of sediment transport in the Po valley, in J. Boardman ed., *Soil Erosion of Agricultural Land*, Wiley, New York, 36–56.

PLEASE, NO ENDNOTES OR FOOTNOTES, references in text only.

For example: (Bottema 1974, 45, 69; Lamb and Tessier 1987; Serre-Bachet et al. 1992; Foster and Grew 1990, Fig. 1)



Please note:

DO NOT USE ANY SORT OF BIBLIOGRAPHIC ABBREVIATION: FULL TITLES ONLY FOR ALL REFERENCES!

LANGUAGE: The papers must be submitted in English.

ILLUSTRATIONS: Please submit line drawings in good quality originals and black-and-white photographs. Illustrations should be numbered in one series in their order of mention. Captions should be listed in a separate file.

DEADLINE: the papers must be submitted by **January 31th, 2020.**

If papers arrive late, the proofs cannot be sent back to the authors for correction.

IMPORTANT: Authors who write in a language different from their mother tongue must have their texts corrected **before** sending them for submission.


Papers which have to be heavily linguistically reviewed and re-written or do not follow the editorial guidelines will be sent back to the authors for correction.

the text (min. 5 – max. 10 pages) in Word,


