5th International Conference

Archaeometallurgy in Europe 2019 Miskole, Sungary - 21st June, 2019





The fifth International Conference Archaeometallurgy in Europe will be held in Miskolc, in Hungary, from the 19th to the 21st of June 2019.

The Conference intends to promote an active dialogue among archaeometallurgy researchers with different specialisations and backgrounds, to create an opportunity to discuss the study of ancient metallurgical processes, and conservation science, and to discuss the application of modern metallurgical experimental methods and techniques to investigate, identify and date ancient artefacts. A further purpose is also that of creating an interaction between institutions and researchers, to facilitate the integration of different approaches and finally to promote contacts and collaborations between scholars from European and non-European countries and from different research areas.

In order to achieve the main goal of the conference, (i.e. emphasising and strengthening the interdisciplinary character and activities of archaeometallurgy), we bring together specialists interested in this topic, to exchange data, and update the knowledge on metallurgical activity in Europe from a global archaeometallurgical perspective. Very welcome contributions are those informing on recently excavated sites, results of analyses of related finds, new analytical methods, results of the latest comparative studies, as well as new trends and results in experimental archaeometallurgy.

Main topics:

- Archaeometallurgy of copper and copper based alloys (case studies, \geq latest results)
- \triangleright Archaeometallurgy of iron (case studies, latest results)
- Archaeometallurgy of precious metals and other non-ferrous metals (e.g. tin, lead and mercury)
- Technology transfers over space and time \triangleright
- Latest experiences of related archaeometric methods and technologies
- \triangleright Comparative studies
